AVAILABILITY

Available throughout the Cooperative's service territory subject to the Cooperative's Terms and Conditions of Service.

APPLICABILITY

This Schedule is applicable to consumers purchasing alternating electricity for single family residential and residential-farm use. Other Ancillary domestic or farm appliances and equipment may be supplied from the residential meter provided their use is primarily non-commercial.

This rate is not applicable to:

- (a) Separately metered farm or domestic facilities such as dryers, brooders, water pumps, etc.
- (b) Club houses, \*trailer camps or any connection for temporary, seasonal or commercial use.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single phase, 60 cycle, at the Cooperative's standard voltages.

MONTHLY RATE

- I. Distribution Delivery Charges
  - A. Base Facilities Charge:  
\$28.70 per month (plus)
  - B. Energy Delivery Charges:  
All KWH delivered @ \$0.015235 per KWH
- II. Plus Generation and Transmission Supply Charges:  
All KWH @ \$0.05317 per KWH

Note: The above Delivery Service and Energy Supply Service charges apply to those Customers who have the Cooperative as their energy service provider. Only the Distribution Delivery Service charges apply to those Customers who have an Electricity Supplier, other than the Cooperative, as their energy service provider.

MINIMUM MONTHLY DISTRIBUTION DELIVERY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge applicable to Part I of the foregoing monthly rate shall be the Base Facilities Charge where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge applicable to Part I shall be increased at the rate of \$0.75 for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required.

**POWER COST ADJUSTMENT RIDER**

The amount of generation and transmission supply charges calculated under Part II of the Monthly Rate is subject to increase or decrease pursuant to the Cooperative's Power Cost Adjustment Rider, Schedule PCA-1.

**TERM OF CONTRACT**

The term of contract is to be not less than twelve (12) months.

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- \* House trailers or mobile homes mounted on permanent foundations and connected with permanent water and permanent Health Department approved sewerage facilities may be served under this Schedule.
